- > You agree to ensure that your dog arrives in a clean condition with clean bedding.
- > You agree to your dog being boarded and exercised with dogs from other households.
- All dogs must be fully vaccinated and free of fleas, ticks or other parasites. You must bring proof of vaccinations when dropping your dog off. Dogs will not be accepted without this proof.
- > Your dog must be sociable and non-aggressive towards other dogs or people and be fully house trained.
- Barkingham Palace is authorised by your signature on the Registration Form to seek and obtain veterinary care if necessary, with release from all liabilities related to transportation, treatment and expense, and you shall reimburse Barkingham Palace for all expenses incurred.
- In any emergency, we will contact you on the emergency telephone number you leave with us, to discuss the best course of action. If we fail to get a response we will contact your vet directly if they are within a 10 mile radius, or we will use our own local veterinary practice.
- You give your permission for emergency first aid procedures to be carried out prior to immediate consultation with a vet if the situation is deemed to be life threatening, such as choking or bleeding, or in the case of a severe allergic reaction, for Piriton to be given.
- You will be liable for any additional expenses incurred should additional food supplies be required, in the event of the supply provided by you running out.
- It is your responsibility to tell us of any problems which might make your dog unsuitable for home boarding, including but not limited to behavioural or health problems, anti-social behaviour, incontinence, excessive loud barking or whining. Failure to do so will be deemed a breach of agreement and you will be liable for costs should it be necessary to transfer your dog to a local boarding kennels.
- The care and safety of your pet is our highest priority. However, due to the unpredictability of animals, Barkingham Palace will not be held liable for the disappearance, death or injury of your pet.
- You are responsible for and agree to pay fully for any damage caused by your dog to other animals or people, or to the property or furnishings contained within the premises of Barkingham Palace, during your dog's stay.
- A non-refundable deposit of 10% is required at the time of booking. Full payment must be made when dropping your dog/s off with us. Payment can be by cheque or cash.
- A charge of 50% of the full booking fee will be made for cancellations with less than 14 days' notice given, and 100% of the full booking fee where less than 7 days' notice is given.
- I am sorry but I am unable to take male dogs that have not been neutered, female dogs that are in season, puppies under 12 months old, or dogs registered under the Dangerous Dogs Act of 1991.
